



Member Guidelines:

Before completing the pre-approval form, please read below. If you are unable to follow the guidelines set forth, you should reconsider joining On Tap Network. We are careful in our member-approval process.

On Tap Network is an OPEN-NETWORKING organization. Our quarterly networking events are open to ALL professions in any county or zone in the Greater Philadelphia area.

Membership Rules for On Tap Network state that only ONE professional per zone in a business category is allowed. As long the professional's territory does not leak into another professional's territory within the same business category, then this does not break the Membership Rules as we are labeled as an Open-Networking organization and Marketing Company on our LLC. You are also permitted promote more than one profession, but you must pay for each membership separately and follow the same zoning rules.

Solicitation Rules:

On Tap Network upholds a strict privacy policy and solicitation rules. Pushing your product to unwilling members or attendees during or after the networking events is strictly prohibited. If a member or attendee mentions they are not interested in your service or product, you are not allowed to continue reaching out by phone or email to "push" your service or product on another person. We will investigate any complaints and take action in regards to un-wanted solicitation and product-pushing. Action usually involves in one warning followed by banning that person from attending any more networking events and if they are a member, we will ask them to leave the group without refund.

Membership Rules and Guidelines:

On Tap Network is an OPEN-NETWORK Organization. Our quarterly networking events are open to ALL professions in any county or zone in the Greater Philadelphia area.

Membership Rules:

More than one profession per person is allowed to join On Tap Network as a member, but must follow zoning rules. Zoning rules are broken up per the below as of January 1st, 2012. Zoning rules will change at any time as more members

join On Tap Network. Zoning rules: As long as one professional's territory does NOT leak into another professional's territory, you are allowed to join the group.

As an On Tap Network member, you must be able to attend at least two (2) events per year. As a Platinum member, you must attend at least one member-only meeting between the quarterly networking events to get into the upcoming networking event for free. For each event, we provide marketing material and we ask members to promote the event via social media, hanging posters in the windows or sending the flyer to their contacts. The more people each member brings to the event, the better the events will be for all of us. On Tap Network is a group that was established to help small to mid-sized business owners grow. On Tap Network also provides social media marketing for each Platinum member. We will promote services and product PER ZONE on social media networks. If you would like to promote any service or event on our website, Facebook page wall or LinkedIn group, you must get permission from the Managing Partners first. You are not able to promote UNLESS you are a Platinum member.

While we do ask how long you have been in your business category, there are no guidelines for inception. If you have just started a business, we believe that networking will help you grow that business and we are happy to help!

Privacy Policy:

On Tap Network is committed to protecting the privacy of our Members and Visitors to our website and the Attendees to our quarterly networking events. Other than the information that is shown on our Member Profiles page, we will not share any other contact information with other members, attendees of our networking events or visitors to our site, nor will we sell information to third parties. Please note that if you attend an On Tap Network event you are responsible for exchanging business cards and/or contact information. We will not release the attendee list or contact information of any one person that is involved with our events. If need be, we will ask the person for permission in writing before releasing anyone's information to another person. This policy goes for EACH of our members as well. Please do not share contact information that you received at one of our events with another person without FIRST asking for

permission in writing. If for any reason, this policy is broken and you are a member, you will be asked to leave the group with no refund and will also not be permitted to attend another event hosted by On Tap Network.
